Election day is Nov. 3!

Virginia voters will decide on three Constitutional Amendments this fall:

Vote NO on Ballot Question 1



It would write virtually unlimited abortion into Virginia's constitution.

Vote NO on Ballot Question 2



It would remove the definition of marriage as the "union between one man and one woman" from Virginia's constitution.

Vote YES on Ballot Question 3



It would restore voting rights to people who have completed their prison sentences.

VOTE NO ON THE EXTREME ABORTION AMENDMENT

VOTING STARTS SEPT. 18. ELECTION DAY IS NOV. 3.

This is an extreme, risky and deadly amendment that puts women's health and safety at risk.

It fails to require care for babies born alive after an attempted abortion, allowing them to be left to die without life-saving treatment.
